

Knoch boys, girls sweep Franklin Invite

Knoch's Adam Tuzikow won the shot put (50 feet, two inches) and the discus (146-8) to help the Knights' boys track and field team take first place at the Franklin Invitational on Saturday.

Knoch scored 125 points to beat out Cathedral Prep (106½).

Also winning events for the Knights were Dillon Schwertz in the 1,600-meter run (4:46.57), Andrew Rumburg-Goodlin in the 400 dash (52.25) as well as the 1,600 and 3,200 relay teams.

Moniteau's boys placed fourth overall with 47 points, led by Victor Santoyo winning the triple jump at 41-6½.

- Knoch's girls came away with first place as well at the Franklin Invite, with top finishes on the track going to Samantha Logan in the 400 dash (62.8), Emily Hertweck in the 800 run (2:38) and Jolene Kunkel in the 1,600 run (5:44).

Knoch's 1,600 and 3,200 relay teams also earned first place.

Placing first in the field were Tori Lark in the high jump (4-8), Allyson Cress in both the shot put (38-6) and discus (110) and Leah Welker in the pole vault (8-6).
